### AQUATIC TOXICITY (E.G. 96 HR. TLM):

**WASTE DISPOSAL METHOD:** IF POSSIBLE, PUMP TO CONTROLLED CONTAINMENT AREA. ABSORB ON CLAY OR SAND. DISPOSE OF IN COMPLIANCE WITH EPA, STATE, AND LOCAL REGULATIONS.

**STEPS TO BE TAKEN IF MATERIAL IS RELEASED OR SPILLED:** IF POSSIBLE PUMP TO CONTROLLED CONTAINMENT AREA. ELIMINATE ALL IGNITION SOURCES (FLARES, FLAMES, INCLUDING PILOT LIGHTS, ELECTRICAL SPARKS). ## SECTION VIII CONTROL MEASURES

### VENTILATION REQUIREMENTS:
